Mitsubishi Fuso Truck and Bus Corporation (hereinafter “MFTBC”) may receive your personal data in some cases as part of its business activities. Protecting your privacy when processing your personal data is an important concern to which we pay particular attention in all of our business processes.

MFTBC processes the personal data received according to the Act on Protection of Personal Information (hereinafter “APPI”) as well as related ministerial ordinances and guidance, Mitsubishi Fuso Group internal policies and this Privacy Statement.

With regard to the handling of employees’ and candidates’ personal data, a separate Privacy Policy regarding employee data applies.

With regard to the handling of information that is collected and transmitted by telematics devices installed in Fuso vehicles, please refer to our Connected Vehicle Data Policy.

If you subscribe to any of our services (such as Truckconnect), additional terms regarding the data transmitted from your vehicle may apply under the relevant service agreement.

## 1. Collection and Processing of Personal Data

In addition to “special care required personal data” (race, creed, social status, medical history, criminal record, and facts regarding suffered damage from a crime etc.), labor union membership, lineage and permanent domicile, as well as information related to healthcare and sexual orientation will not be collected, processed, or provided to third parties, unless required by APPI and its related acts and guidelines, or unless a consent has been acquired.

MFTBC takes the utmost care to prevent leaks, falsification, loss, etc. of your personal data by regular internal audits and continuous improvements of its security measures.  
MFTBC also implement appropriate security measures and strive to prevent risks such as leakage, alteration, and loss of personal data by conducting periodic audits of how we handle our customers’ personal data and by continuously working to improve our practices.

When you visit our website, our web server records the IP address assigned to you by your Internet service provider, the website from which you were directed to our website, the specific pages you visit on our website, as well as the date and time of your visit. As for personal data, we only collect and store the data you provide to us when you register, participate in surveys or competition, or enter into a contract with us.

## 2. Purpose of Utilization of Personal Data incl. Data Sharing

MFTBC will not use your personal data for any purposes other than those stated below. However, the purposes of utilization set out below may be changed to the extent reasonably recognized as having relevance to the original purposes. If we change the purposes of utilization, we shall, in principle, notify you in writing or by other means, or announce it on our homepage (<http://www.mitsubishi-fuso.com/>).

- (1) Provision of information on new products, periodic inspections, vehicle inspections and other services
- (2) Provision of price quotations for our products and services, including new and used vehicles, parts and vehicle inspection services
- (3) Provision of data on products and services, such as non-life insurance (mutual aid), life insurance and ancillary or related services, offered by insurance companies and mutual aid associations\* for which MFTBC acts as an agency  
\* For the insurance companies and mutual aid associations with which we do business, please refer to Section 6.
- (4) Provision of guidance and implementation of contract procedures relating to various applications and memberships
- (5) Provision of guidance and implementation of procedures relating to after-sales services following product purchase
- (6) Handling of and responses to requests and inquiries, and provision of our feedback
- (7) Provision of communications regarding various events and campaigns, as well as shipment of products and other items
- (8) Surveys on product development and customer satisfaction
- (9) Credit decision and Credit management
- (10) Implementation of safety measures for vehicles manufactured by MFTBC (including early collection of vehicles subject to recalls, remedial measures and service campaigns, as well as provision of information as stipulated in Article 57-2 of the Road Transport Vehicle Act)
- (11) Preparation of statistical information to be used for improving the services of MFTBC, MFTBC's authorized dealers, and Archion Group, its subsidiaries as well as affiliated companies
- (12) Preparation of statistical information to be used for new product development by MFTBC, MFTBC's authorized dealers, and Archion Group, its subsidiaries as well as affiliated companies
- (13) Any other purposes of use separately specified, notified or disclosed to customers by MFTBC
- (14) Joint use and provision, in written or electronic form, of the following personal data to MFTBC's authorized dealers and Archion Group, its subsidiaries as well as affiliated companies:  
Customer contact details such as full name, address, phone number, fax number and e-mail address; workplace information (company name, department/section, position, address, phone number and fax number); contract-related information such as delivery addresses; vehicle-related information such as vehicle purchase history, service usage history and telematics data; as well as details of customer inquiries.
- (15) Joint use and provision, in written or electronic form, of the following personal data to member companies of the Japan Automobile Dealers Association:  
Customer full name, date of birth, contact details such as address and phone number; information relating to the customer's requests, inquiries and transactions; workplace information; and information relating to the relevant contract, such as contract date, product name, contract amount, number of installments, outstanding balance and monthly payment status.
- (16) Other cases permitted under laws and regulations\*

Provision of personal data to government authorities will be made only where required by law and after assessing the necessity of such disclosure and its impact on the customer.

### 3. Data Subject Rights

MFTBC will respond to your requests in relation to your personal data as set out below, in accordance with laws and regulations.

- **Disclosure of Personal Data**  
Where necessary, we will disclose the categories of your personal data (e.g. “full name”, “address”, etc.).
- **Correction of Personal Data**  
Where necessary, we will correct/update your personal data (e.g. full name, address etc.).
- **Suspension of Use of Personal Data**  
Where necessary, we will suspend the use of your personal data and its provision to third parties.
- **Deletion of Personal Data**  
Where necessary, we will delete all your personal data retained by us.

## **4. Security Control Measures**

MFTBC implement security control measures to protect the personal data we handle from manipulation, loss, destruction, and unauthorized access.

Examples of such security control measures are as follows:

### **Organizational Security Control Measures**

- Process for handling and reporting of data breaches in place
- Dedicated policies on IT security and Data Compliance
- Dedicated departments responsible for Compliance and IT Security
- Dedicated personnel responsible for Data Protection and IT Security
- Appointment of data protection promoters within all departments

### **Personnel-related Security Control Measures**

- Agreement to confidentiality policies at the time of hiring employees
- Regular mandatory trainings
- Periodic notices from Compliance Department, IT Department or management
- Additional events or campaign activities to promote awareness

### **Physical Security Control Measures**

- Entry to general premises guarded
- Entry to specific areas only with special clearance (e.g. HR department)

### **Technological Security Control Measures**

- Access to systems only limited to key personnel
- Installation of additional software only via prior-authorization
- Implementation of measures commensurate with the security classification of each system

### **External Security Control Measures**

- Implementation and performance of selection guidelines for business partners
- Implementation of additional data processing agreements with business partners
- In cases of providing or outsourcing personal data to third countries, ensuring compliance with the Personal Information Protection Commission's guidelines on third countries, and implementing MFTBC's internal risk guidelines as well as experience-based risk assessments

## **5. Provision of Personal Data to External Parties**

MFTBC provides your personal data to third parties only in the following cases:

- (1) In cases where MFTBC obtained your consent

- (2) In cases where MFTBC outsources handling of personal data within the scope necessary for the achievement of the Purpose of Utilization
- (3) In cases where personal data is transferred as result of a merger, company split, or business transfer, etc.
- (4) In cases of joint use of personal data with the entities specified in Section 6
- (5) In cases permitted under laws and regulations

## 6. Joint Utilization of Personal Data

We may jointly use your personal data as set out below.
